

# 2010 Minnesota High Power Match & Service Rifle Championships

## Match Schedule:

Saturday June 26<sup>th</sup> - Firing commences at 9:00 AM

### Match 6: Minnesota High Power Rifle Team Championships

Stage 1: 200 yards standing slow fire (2 sighters & 20 shots for record - Block Time 47 minutes/pair- rule 8.3a)

Stage 2: 200 yards sitting rapid fire (2 sighters & 2 ten shot strings, 60 seconds/string)

*NOTE: Each relay will fire Stage 2 upon completion of Stage 1.*

Stage 3: 300 yards prone rapid fire (2 sighters & 2 ten shot strings, 70 seconds/string)

Stage 4: 600 yards prone slow fire (2 sighters & 20 shots for record - Block Time 47 minutes/pair- rule 8.3a)

Sunday June 27<sup>th</sup> - Firing commences at 9:00 AM

### Minnesota High Power Match & Service Rifle Championships

Match 1: 200 yards standing slow fire (2 sighters & 20 shots for record in 22 minutes)

Match 2: 200 yards sitting rapid fire (2 sighters & 2 ten shot strings, 60 seconds/string)

*NOTE: Each relay will fire Match 2 upon completion of Match 1.*

Match 3: 300 yards prone rapid fire (2 sighters & 2 ten shot strings, 70 seconds/string)

Match 4: 600 yards prone slow fire (2 sighters & 20 shots for record in 22 minutes)

Match 5: Grand Aggregate (scores of Matches 1-4 combined)

**Registration:** No pre-registration. Entries will be accepted at the statistical office between 7-8:40AM. Firing point & relay assignments will be finalized at that time. No entries will be accepted after that time. **Be on time!!!**

*\*\* If any Team shooter does NOT fire the individual match, they must also pay these fees.*

Cash, Check (payable to Elk River Sportsman Club) or NRA points will be accepted.

**Classification:** The NRA Classification system will be used in all matches. If there are less than 5 competitors in any Class, they will be combined with the next higher Class, until the 5-competitor minimum is satisfied. High Masters will not be combined with any other Class. If there are less than 5 High Masters competing, they will be eligible for Match Winner awards only. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Service Rifle shooters must declare whether they are competing in the Service Rifle or Match Rifle category.

**Rules:** \*\*\*Current NRA rules will apply. There have been multiple changes for 2010.\*\*\*

**Targets:** 200 yards – SR    300 yards – SR3    600 yards – MR

**Challenges:** \$2.00 per challenge (Competitors should have exact change.)

**Range Capacity:** 65 Individuals    13 Teams

**Eligibility:** Elk River Sportsman Club reserves the right to reject any entry.

- Individual: Minnesota residents must be members of the MRRA. Residents of other states must be members of their home state association (Be prepared to show proof of membership) or must join the MRRA.
- Teams: Teams may represent Clubs (rule 2.11), Service/Guard/Reserve (rule 2.13) or Junior Clubs (2.18). Minnesota Clubs must be members of the MRRA. "Pick-up" teams are encouraged, but will not be eligible for awards.

- All competitors must sign a waiver of liability for the Elk River Sportsman Club

**Scoring and Pit Service:** Competitors will be required to perform scoring and marking (target pulling) for other competitors. Competitors should be aware of the requirements of rules 14.3.1, (Scorer's Duties), 14.14 (Target Puller Responsibilities) and 16.1 (Protests).

**Award Schedule:** Award payback depends upon the number of entries. Match results will be posted on the MRRA website. Competitors who want a printed copy must furnish a self addressed stamped envelope at the time of registration.

- Team: Award will be presented to the High Match Rifle (Rules 3.3-3.1.1) & High Service Rifle (3.1-3.1.3) Teams. Mixed teams (Match & Service Rifle) must compete in the Match Rifle Class. If a non-Minnesota Team fires the highest Grand Aggregate score, a High Non-Resident Team award will be presented.
- Individual: At minimum, awards will be presented to the following: High Match Rifle (3.3-3.1.1), High Service Rifle (3.1-3.1.3), High Junior (2.3) & 1st Place in each class [subject to 5-competitor per class minimum]. Grand Aggregate Match & Service Rifle Winners will be awarded to the high scoring Minnesota resident. If a non-Minnesota Resident fires the highest Grand Aggregate score, a High Non-Resident award will be presented.

**Special Awards:** Special awards (Match 5 only) will be presented for the following Categories: High Woman, High Service (2.5, 2.6, 2.7), High Senior (2.2.1) & High Grand Senior (2.2.2) [subject to 5-competitor per class minimum]. Competitor must indicate eligibility on the match entry form.

**Ties:** – Unbreakable ties (rule 15.13) in Match 2 and/or 3 will be broken by a shoot-off of the tied match. If necessary, shoot-off(s) will be fired after completion of Match 4.

**Rifles/Scopes Available:** A limited number of Rifles & Spotting Scopes will be available for competitors who do not have them. Arrangements must be made in advance. Juniors (less than 18 yrs) planning to borrow rifles must provide written authorization from Parent/Legal Guardian (contact Match Director for details).

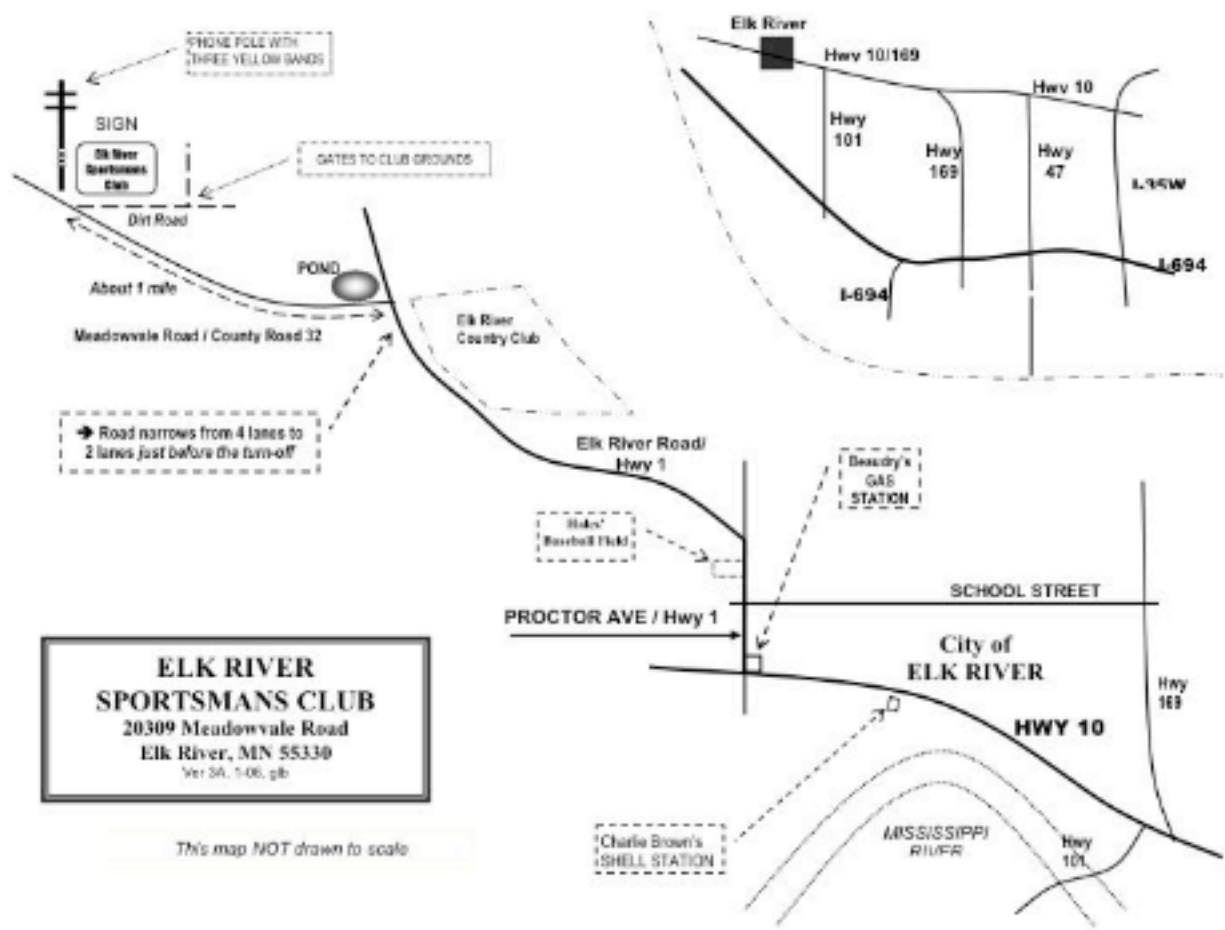
**Saturday BBQ:** The Elk River Sportsman Club is planning a barbeque for Saturday (after completion of Match 6). Stay tuned for details.

**Important Notes:** Due to a previous incident, the Elk River Sportsman Club has been forced to institute a "zero tolerance" policy for shots that do not strike a target (note rule 14.8). Any competitor who fires a shot, which does not strike a target, is disqualified from the match and must remove their equipment from the firing line. Safety briefings will be conducted in the pits and at the ready line.
