

## Elk River Sportsman's Club Spring Wind Clinic

### And Mid-Range Match

The Elk River Sportsman's Club is proud to host this fantastic event. The event will consist of a wind reading/shooting clinic followed by a delicious lunch. After the lunch, (2) 20 shot matches will be fired at the 600 yard line of the club's KD Range. These matches will be 2 shooter/team events with the intent of practicing your wind reading skills by coaching your teammate. The instructors will be Steve Knutson and Rick Hunt, both coaches for the US National F-Class Team. This is a rare chance to learn from the best coaches in the country! The match will continue on the second day with NRA Approved (4) 20 shot matches at 600 yards.

Registration opens at 7:30am. Clinic starts at 9:00am Sharp. Saturday match starts at 1:00pm.

### Saturday, April 21<sup>th</sup> 1:00pm Wind Clinic and F-Class/ Prone 2 Shooter/ Team Match

**\*\*Not NRA Approved\*\***

*All matches are prone slow fire, 2 sighters & 20 shots for record per shooter in 40 minutes. All matches MUST be fired in the order indicated.*

Following the wind reading/shooting clinic, a lunch will be served. The 2 shooter/team matches will start after the lunch and continue until concluded or sunset. Coaching and discussions will be part of the team matches. This event is meant to be a learning experience.

Match 1: 600 yards Any\* Rifle/Any Sight

Match 2: 600 yards Any\* Rifle/Any Sight

Match 3: Aggregate of Match 11 and 12

\* No muzzlebrakes or Schuetzen style buttplates.

\*Matches 1 &2 must be shot with the same rifle.

### Sunday, April 22<sup>th</sup> 9:00am Individual F-Class and Prone \*\*NRA Approved\*\*

*All matches are prone slow fire, 2 sighters & 20 shots for record in 22 minutes. All matches MUST be fired in the order indicated.*

Registration begins each day at 7:30am. Registration closes at 8:30am. Pits sealed Sunday at 8:45am. Firing begins Sunday at 9:00am.

Match 21: 600 yards Any\*Rifle/Any Sight

Match 22: 600 yards Any\*Rifle/Any Sight

Match 23: 600 yards Any\*Rifle/Any Sight

Match 24: 600 yards Any\*Rifle/Any Sight

\* No muzzlebrakes or Schuetzen style buttplates.

\*Matches 21-24 must be shot with the same rifle.

Match 25: Aggregate of Match 21,22,23,24

**Classification:** The NRA Classification system will be used in all matches. If there are less than 5 competitors in any classification, they will be combined with the next higher class, until the 5-competitor minimum is satisfied. High Masters will not be combined with any other classification. If there are less than 5 High Masters competing, they will be eligible for Match Winner only. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class.

**Fees including NRA fees, and all applicable taxes:**

Saturday Match, Lunch and clinic \$ 25 (Not NRA Approved)

Lunch and Clinic, no shooting \$ 20

Sunday Match \$ 25 (NRA Approved)

Both days matches, lunch and clinic \$45

**Preregistration is encouraged, squadding preference will be given to preregistered shooters**

**Challenges:** \$2.00 per challenge (Competitors should have exact change.)

**Range Capacity:** 80 Individuals

**Eligibility:** All competitors must be NRA members. Elk River Sportsman's Club reserves the right to reject any entry.

**Targets:** F-Class 600 yards – MRFC

Mid-Range 600 yards – MR

**Award Schedule:** Award payback depends upon the number of entries. At minimum awards will be presented to the following: Match Winner, High Junior & 1<sup>st</sup> Place in each class (subject to 5-competitor per class minimum). The 10% rule will apply to further awards. F-T/R, F-Open, Match Rifle and Service Rifle will be separate classes subject to the 5 competitor minimum.

**Registration:** Pre-registration is strongly encouraged. Entries will be accepted at the statistical office between 7:30am to 8:30am. Firing point & relay assignments will be made at that time. No entries will be accepted after 8:30am. Mandatory safety meeting before match begins. All match participants must have a confirmed 600 yard zero for their rifle before registering. Be on time!!!

**Rifles/Scopes Available:** A limited number of Rifles & Spotting Scopes will be available for competitors who do not have them. Arrangements must be made in advance. Juniors less than 18 yrs, wishing to borrow rifles, must provide written authorization from Parent/Legal Guardian (contact Match Director for details).
