Over the Course

Match 1: 200 yards standing slow fire (2 sighters & 20 shots for record in 22 minutes)

Match 2: 200 yards sitting rapid fire (2 sighters & 2 ten shot strings, 60 seconds/string)

NOTE: Each relay will fire Match 2 upon completion of Match 1.

Match 3: 300 yards prone rapid fire (2 sighters & 2 ten shot strings, 70 seconds/string)

Match 4: 600 yards prone slow fire (2 sighters & 20 shots for record in 22 minutes)

Match 5: Aggregate (scores of Matches 1-4 combined)

Classification: The NRA Classification system will be used in all matches. If there are less than 5 competitors in any classification, they will be combined with the next higher class, until the 5-competitor minimum is satisfied. High Masters will not be combined with any other classification. If there are less than 5 High Masters competing, they will be eligible for Match Winner only. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class.

Eligibility: Elk River Sportsman Club reserves the right to reject any entry.

Targets: Over the Course 200 yards – SR 300 yards – SR3 600 yards – MR
 Mid-Range 600 yards – MR
 F-Class 600 yards – MRFC

Award Schedule: Award payback depends upon the number of entries. At minimum awards will be presented to the following: Match Winner, High Junior & 1st Place in each class (subject to 5-competitor per class minimum). The 10% rule will apply to further awards.

Registration: No pre-registration. Entries will be accepted at the statistical office between 7-8:45AM. Firing point & relay assignments will be made at that time. No entries will be accepted after 8:45AM. Be on time!!!

Rifles/Scopes Available: A limited number of Rifles & Spotting Scopes will be available for competitors who do not have them. Arrangements must be made in advance. Juniors less than 18 yrs, wishing to borrow rifles, must provide written authorization from Parent/Legal Guardian (contact Match Director for details).
