### **MATCH SCHEDULE**

All firing commences on the 800 yards line at 11.00 am.

Match will be starting later to accommodate the training schedule of the U.S. National Rifle Team.

### **SUNDAY May 23<sup>rd</sup>**

Stage 1: 800 yards 15 shots for record in 30 minutes. unlimited sighting shot.  
Coaching allowed at 800 yards during sighting shots only

Stage 2: 900 yards 2 sighting shots and 15 shots for record in 22 minutes

Stage 3: 1000 yards 2 sighting shots and 15 shots for record in 22 minutes

Grand Match Winner: Aggregate scores of Matches 1-3 combined.  
The Wadekamper Trophy will be awarded to the high aggregate using <156 grain bullet.  
A smaller trophy will be awarded to high aggregate using >156 grain bullet

The highest scoring Minnesota resident for the Match will be declared the Rudy Wadekamper Memorial Palma Champion.

**Grand Match Winner must used legal Palma or Service Rifle with metallic only**

Cash, check (payable to GRRC or NRA points will be accepted).

Classification: Current NRA High Power Rifle and NRA Long Range Classification rules will apply.

If there are less than 5 competitors in any classification, they will be combined with the next higher class, until the 5-competitors minimum is satisfied. High Masters will not be combined with any other classification. If there are less than 5 High Masters competing, they will be eligible for Match Winner only. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class.

Empty chamber indicators (Rule 3.21) will be available at the range and **MUST** be used by all competitors.

The Palma Match is open to Palma and Long-range shooters who are members of NRA. proof of membership is required.

Registration: No pre-registration. Entries will be accepted at the Red Shed/statistical office between -9:45 am. Match is limited to 3 relays of 14 shooters per relay - 42 competitors.

Awards Schedule: Award payback depends upon the number of entries.

Challenges: \$2.00 per challenge. Competitors should have exact change.

Targets: NRA LR target.

Duties: Competitors will be required to score and provide pit service to each other. Pit pullers may be available on a limited basis.

**“F” CLASS COMPETITORS:** All events are open to participation by F-Class competitors. F-Class competitors will compete only among themselves and are eligible for “F”-Class awards in the matches. F-Class competitors will not shoot on special F-Class target. Awards in the F-Class will be made based upon a minimum number of five (5) F-Class competitors in that Matches. “F” Class – competitors may use sand bag or bipod rests from the ground, no bench rests allowed . Any rifle, caliber .34 or smaller may be used (no muzzle brakes allowed). There are no restrictions on sights

***GRRC 6 shot rule applies***, competitors must place a shot on paper within the first 6 sighting shots or that shooter will be asked to remove his/her gear from the line and will be disqualified from competition - (know your zero's.) Coaching allowed during 800 yard sighting shots only.

Directions: Take 1-35 North of the Twin Cities to County Rd. 10-Harris exit (4 miles north of North Branch and approximately 16 miles south of Pine City). Go West on County Road 10 (½ mile) to County Road 61 (gravel to the north). Go north on 61 approximately 1¼ mile to a sharp left turn in the road. The GRRC gate is approximately 100 yards past bend on the north (right). Enter range and proceed right at the Y, go to the Red Shed on the 1000-yard line for squadding.

**New and safe state of the art NRA approved pits.**

Camping and picnic area will open Thursday by prior arrangement only. All. resorts, restaurants, lodging facilities and public swimming are available within 10 minutes of the range.
