Seniors

(Rule 2.2.1) Shooter may fire with scope sights on iron sight day with no awards and no aggregate. Shooters who use only a scope are not eligible to win the state championship but can shoot for awards on anysight day by paying the regular match fees.

Challenge fee of \$2.00 will be assessed to each challenge made and refunded if justified. See the current smallbore rule book for proper procedure.

Rules

NRA Rule 3.2 will govern. Any competitor not having a NRA classification will fire in the master class. Rule 19.6 will govern your assigned classification. If there are less than five entries in a class, they will be moved into the next higher class.

Awards

Approximately 60% of the entry fee will be returned to the competitors in the form of cash and/or award points.

The high MN state resident will receive a state plaque and the traveling Purdy Trophy.

Resident junior grand aggregate winner will receive a plaque from the state association.
