RULE: Current NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules will govern.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to any individual member of the NRA. Junior competitors may be individual members of the NRA or members of an NRA affiliated Junior Rifle Club.

Teams will consist of 2 firing members, a captain and/or coach if desired, and will represent either a club affiliated with the NRA, Rule 2.11, 2.11.1, a law enforcement agency, Rule 2.14, a Regular Service Unit, or a Reserve unit (including National Guard) Rule 2.13. The team captain and/or coach may be firing members of the team.

ENTRIES:

Individuals: Entries in individual events can be made at the range on match day. NRA classification and NRA number will be needed. Please make checks payable to the Hibbing Rifle & Pistol Club. Mail all entries to Herb Pasch.

Entries are limited to 40 competitors.

FEES:

NRA Individual registration fee: \$9.00 per competitor

Individual matches: \$2.00 per match

Team Match: \$6.00 per team(NRA team Fee \$5.00)

Package Fee: \$27.00 (for individual matches only)
(1 of 4)

TIME OF FIRING: Firing will commence each day at 9:00 A.M.

SOUVENIR PINS: Will be given to each individual who competes.

RIFLE: Rule 3.2

TARGET: NRA A-23 target will be used.

CHALLENGES: A challenge fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each challenge made. See NRA Rule 16 for correct procedure.

SQUADDING TICKETS: All matches will be squadded. Squadding will be done from the Statistical Office. **NRA Membership numbers & classification cards may be checked by the Statistical Officer.**

Statistical Officer: Squadding information for team matches will be announced on range. A competitor who fails to present himself at the proper firing point when his relay is called may lose his right to compete in that event

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA classification system will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6 - assigned Classification, or 19.2 - Temporary Classification, may be used in making entry in an NRA Regional tournament.

AWARDS: To the Winner, 2nd, and 3rd place overall medallions (provided entries warrant) and the winning team awards in the team matches are furnished by the NRA. The tournament sponsor will provide awards for all fired matches and aggregates. Sponsor will post on the bulletin board an award schedule after entries have closed and before the tournament begins. (Generally at least 50% of match entry fees should be given in awards to the class/category winners.)

CLASS AND CATEGORY: Class and category will be determined by the number of entries in each. Classes and categories that have enough entries to stand alone, will. Classes/categories with insufficient entries will be combined for awards. (Exception, : Camp Perry entry fee credit certificates). Tournament sponsor will include the award distribution he prefers, i.e. 1st place for 5 entries, 2nd place for 8 entries, 3rd place for 13 entries, etc.

SPECIAL AWARDS: Optional (Senior & Junior) –An individual winning a place award shall be entitled to Special Awards for which he or she is qualified, but may not win a category/class award in the same match. Such awards will be passed down to the next eligible competitor. To be eligible for a Special Award the individual must indicate on his or her entry card the groups represented.

CLASS AWARDS: Optional (after the winner in each class is provided for) – The category/class awards will also be passed down, as described above, if an individual is the winner of a Special Award.

REGIONAL AWARDS SCHEDULE

(Furnished by the NRA)

GRAND AGGREGATE

Winner: NRA Regional Gold Medallion (with a minimum of 5 shooters)
2nd Place: NRA Regional Silver Medallion (with a minimum of 10 shooters)
3rd Place: NRA Regional Bronze Medallion (with minimum of 15 shooters)

AWARDS FOR FIRED TEAM MATCHES - METALLIC SIGHT AND ANY SIGHT

NRA and Conventional 3-Position Only - 5 Award Points for each team member (of the winning team) in each team match (furnished by NRA). All other awards furnished by tournament sponsor. (Awards to the Open Team Match winners are the minimum awards required.)

NRA NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE AWARD

Certificates for 50% Off Camp Perry entry fees are awarded to Class winners. Only one award may be earned per class. At least 10 shooters must be in a class to win a certificate. Classes may be combined upward (NRA Rule 9.8.1) to make a class of 10 shooters. Regionals of less than ten shooters are not eligible for the NRA National Smallbore Rifle Championship Certificate. Certificates are won in NRA Conventional/Metric Prone Regional and in NRA 3-Position or Conventional Position Regional. Only one Prone certificate may be won per year. Only one Position Certificate may be earned per year. A shooter may earn one prone and one position certificate per year and both certificates may be applied to the National Smallbore Rifle Championships if a shooter desires to shoot both championships. Certificates may be passed down to the next lower shooter in a class at the same Regional Tournament. Certificates are the property of the NRA who may refuse to honor any certificates for any reason at anytime. **(For 2007 only, competitors may not combine Camp Perry Credits won in 2007 and Camp Perry Certificates won in 2008).**

AWARDS FURNISHED BY TOURNAMENT SPONSOR

AWARDS: Approximately 60% of the entry fees will be returned to the competitor in the form of cash and/or award points.
