Rules

NRA rule 3.2 will govern. Any competitor not having a NRA classification will fire in the master class. Rule 19.6 will govern your assigned classification. If there are less than five entries in a class, they will be moved into the next higher class.

Awards

Approximately 60% of the entry fees will be returned to the competitor in the form of cash and/or award points. The state resident champion will receive a plaque from the state association. The MN state junior champion will receive a plaque.
