Rules: Govern by the NRA International air rifle rules
Rifle: Rule 3.6, Air rifle
Sights: Metallic sights only
Distance: 10 meters
Sighting Shots: Rule 9.2
Time Limits: 20 minutes per 10-bull target
Target: NRA AR 5/10
Tie Scores: Will be broken by rule 15.3 individual, and 15.7 for teams
Awards: Provided by the NRA
Team Match: 3 person teams; Team score is taken from the combined individual scores of each team member, team must be declared before firing begins.
Relays: 10:45 a.m. and 2:15 p.m.

SPORTER STANDING AIR RIFLE

Course of Fire: 40 shots standing
Rules: Govern by the NRA Sporter air rifle rules
Rifle: Rule 3.2, Air rifle
Sights: Metallic sights only
Distance: 10 meters
Sighting Shots: Rule 9.2
Time Limits: 20 minutes per 10-bull target
Target: NRA AR 5/10
Tie Scores: Will be broken by rule 15.3 individual, and 15.7 for teams
Awards: Provided by the NRA
Team Match: 4 person teams; Team score is taken from the combined individual scores of each team member, team must be declared before firing begins.
Relays: 10:45 a.m. and 2:15 p.m.

3 POSITION AIR RIFLE (precision and sporter)

Course of Fire:	20 Shots at each position: prone, standing, and kneeling in that order
Rules:	Govern by the 3-Position Sporter & 3-Position Precision Air Rifle rules
Sights:	Metallic sights only
Distance:	10 meters
Sighting Shots:	Unlimited, but once the first shot is fired for score, no further sighting shots may be taken
Time Limits:	Prone and kneeling 1.5 minutes per shot, standing 2 minutes per shot
Target:	NRA AR 5/10
Tie Scores:	Will be broken by rule 15.3 individual, and 15.7 for teams
Awards:	Provided by the NRA
Team Match:	4 person teams; Team score is taken from the combined individual scores of each team member, team must be declared before firing begins.
Relays:	8:30 a.m. and 12:30 p.m. (a 4:00 relay may be added if needed)

To stream line the event, and not require juniors to wait hours between matches, it is requested that you shoot the 3P match immediately followed by the International (standing) match if shooting both matches. If circumstances require you to shoot the International first, please let me know, and we will do everything possible to get you set for matches in that order.

Ear and Eye protection required. Open bolt indicator (weed whip) is required.

Team fees and team member designation can be completed the day of the match.

Plan to arrive 1 hour prior to match starting time to complete registration paper work.
