

**MN State Outdoor Conventional Prone Smallbore Rifle Championship Bulletin  
St. Francis, MN September 28, 2008**

The morning of September 28, 2008 was cold and rainy but it didn't dampen the enthusiasm for the MN Conventional Smallbore State Championship. 16 shooters competed for the State Championship. Shooters included two Intermediate Juniors (one female shooter), four Sub Juniors and 10 Adults. The 160 round match went off without a hitch. The Jury was consulted several times to insure accurate scoring on a couple of targets.

When the day ended Lance Peters of Maplewood, MN was the MN Champion with a score of 1593-115X. In the process Lance may have set three National Records. Presently the Conventional Prone One Day-160 shots- Metallic and Any Sight Record Categories as follows: Open – 1589-101X, Civilian – 1589-101X & Senior 1586-104X. We look forward to hearing the NRA's official word on Lance's scores!

Emily Quiner shot a 1582-81X to Claim the MN State Junior Championship and Women's Title.  
Patrick Sunderman shot the high Sub Junior score of 1540-50X
