Rules: Current NRA Smallbore Rifle will govern.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all competitors, membership in the NRA is not required.

ENTRIES:

Individuals: Entries in individual events will be made by using the enclosed registration entry form, accompanied by check or money order. Circle the number of each event in which you wish to fire. Be sure to indicate your correct NRA classification and NRA membership number if you have one. If you are not a NRA member, a number will be assigned you, for classification purposes only.

Entries Close: Individual Match entries must be received no later than 8:15 AM opening of the tournament.

Entries Limited: Entries are limited to 40 competitors.

Post Entries: Post entries will be accepted up to the stated limit of the range provided such entries will not require the Squadding of extra relays.

FEES:

Individual matches: \$25.00 per competitor a day (NRA / MRRRA fee \$9.00, includes MN Sales Tax)

Junior Discount (no cash awards): \$10.00 per day

Adult Package Fee (both days): \$45.00

TIME OF FIRING: Firing will commence each day at 9:00am rain or sun shine.

RIFLE: Rule 3.2

TARGET: NRA Official Targets will be used (Section 4, NRA Rules).

CHALLENGES: A challenge fee of \$3.00 will be charged for each challenge made. (NRA Rule Book section 16).

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Squadding will be done by the Statistical Office. Competitors are responsible for proof of classification. Squadding information for team matches will be announced on range. A competitor who fails to present himself at the proper firing point when his relay is called may lose his right to compete in that event.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA classification system will be used in all matches. NRA classification cards may be checked by the Statistical Officer. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6 - Assigned Classification, or 19.2 - Temporary Classification, may be used in making entry in an NRA MN State Championship tournament.

AWARDS: To the Winner, 2nd, and 3rd place overall a medallion (provided entries warrant). To the winning team 1st place team medals to each firing member. Awards are furnished by the NRA. The tournament sponsor will provide other awards for all fired matches and aggregates. Sponsor will post on the bulletin board an award schedule after entries have closed and before the tournament begin. All Awards will be in cash not to exceed 20% of total Entry Fees. You must be present to collect Awards. Juniors waive the discount if they wish to receive cash awards.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

Seniors may use any sight in the metallic sight matches. State Champion must be a Minnesota Resident and be a member of MN Rifle & Revolver Association.

MN STATE CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS SCHEDULE

CATEGORY AND CLASS AWARDS (GRAND AGGREGATE)

For each class in each category:

- 1st Place - minimum of 5 shooters in category/class
- 2nd Place - with 8 or more shooters in category/class
- 3rd Place - with 13 or more shooters in category/class

Winner: Metallic Sight Aggregate
Any Sight Aggregate

CATEGORY AND CLASS AWARDS: In the metallic sight aggregate or any sight aggregate. For each class in each category.

- 1st Place - minimum of 5 shooters in category/class
- 2nd Place - with 8 or more shooters in category/class
- 3rd Place - with 13 or more shooters in category/class

AWARDS FOR INDIVIDUAL FIRED MATCHES

The number of competitors in a class in a category will determine the amount of awards as above. Five competitors establish a class in a category and 1st place, 8 competitors 2nd place, 13 competitors, 3rd etc. All Awards will be in cash not to exceed 25% of total Entry Fees. You must be present to collect Awards.
