Eligibility:

This match is open to any shooter.

Location:

Minneapolis Rifle Club small bore range (located on Minnetonka Fish & Game Club Property) 8310 Hill and Dale Road, St. Francis MN 55330. See mrra.org for directions or call the contact below.

Time: Firing starts promptly at 9:00 AM, squadding will be completed by 8:45 AM.

Course of Fire:

All Matches shot from the prone position, time allowed for target changes.

Match 1 50 yards, A-23 target, 40 shots, 5 shots per bull, 20/20 minutes, metallic sights.

Match 2 Dewar Course A-23-5/A-25 targets, 20 shots each range, 5/10 shots per bull, 20/20 minutes, metallic sights.

Match 3 100 yards, A-25 target, 40 shots, 10 shots per bull, any sight.

Match 4 50 meters, A-26 target, 40 shots, 5 shots per bull, 20/20 minutes, any sight.

Match 5 – aggregate of Matches 1, 2, 3 & 4.

Fees:

Registration: Adults = \$20.00 (includes MN Sales Taxes, range fee, and awards)

Juniors = \$10.00 (includes MN Sales Taxes and range fee. No awards)

NOTE - Juniors wishing to compete for open cash awards must pay the adult entry fee.

Governing Rules:

NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules, Revised January, 2010

NRA Rule 3.2 will govern rifles. NRA Rule 19.2 any competitor not having a NRA classification will fire in the master class. Rule 19.8.1 will govern your assigned class. If there are less than five entries in a class, they will be moved into the next higher class.

Special Conditions: Seniors may use any sight for the entire course of fire. F-Class welcome but awards will only be given if there are 5 shooters for a Class.

Challenges:

\$3.00 challenge fee will be charged for each challenge and refunded if challenge is justified. See NRA Rules 16.1 for details.

Awards:

Approximately 30% of the entry fees will be returned to the competitors in the form of cash and/or award points. Five Shooters are required to form a Class. If you think you have an award coming, please do not leave. Awards not collected by winner at end of match will be donated to MRC.

Squadding:

All matches will be squadded by classification if possible. Score cards will be issued upon registration check-in. NRA identification cards and classification cards must be available.

Notes:

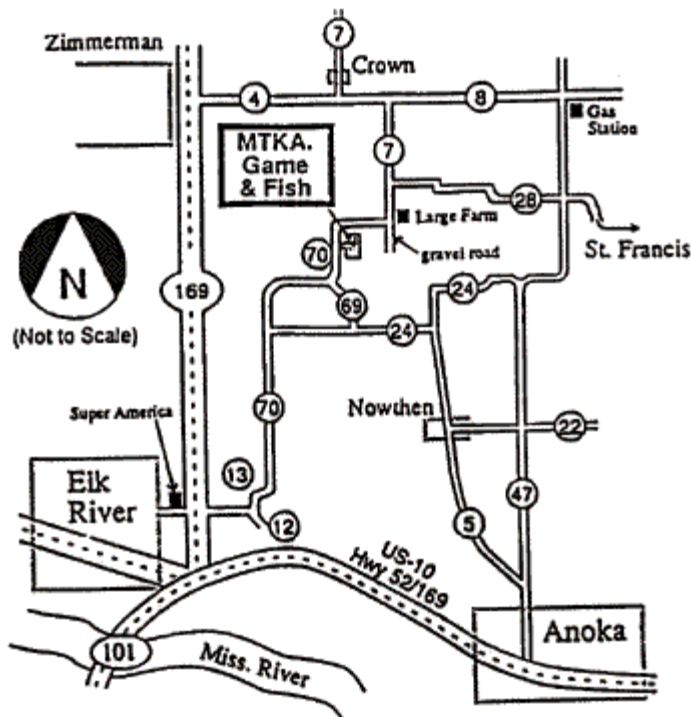
Shooters are required to bring their own target clips and lunch.
