

Olympic Smallbore Minneapolis Rifle Club

In an effort to expand International Shooting Activity, and to bring the use of the smallbore range more into line as a complementary program to that which occurs on the 300 meter range.

Minneapolis Rifle Club will be hosting two offhand smallbore rifle matches on the third Saturday of each month starting at 1PM. One match will be shot at 50 meters at the A-50 target. The other will be shot at 100 yards using the offhand Schuetzen target. Participants will have to select one match or the other to shoot. Each match will be 60 shots for record with sighters allowed over a two hour period.

This is an attempt to expand Olympic smallbore activity as well as reintroduce the traditional Schuetzen course of fire. Any sights are allowed for the Schuetzen match, and only iron sights for the 50 meter match.

The fee will be \$10 for adults and \$5 for Juniors for those not already entered in the international free pistol league (which is shot the same day).
