

**MINNESOTA SERVICE RIFLE CHAMPIONSHIP

TOURNAMENT NAME: MINNESOTA SERVICE RIFLE STATE
CHAMPIONSHIP & LEG MATCH,
(NRA REGISTERED, MRRA AND CMP
SANCTIONED).

DATE: Sept. 17-18, 2011

MOST IMPORTANT: PUH-LEESE drive slowly (20 MPH to gate & 10 MPH after)

COMPETITION OPEN TO: Any NRA member who is also a member of the MRRA or their own state association, if a non-resident. Memberships will be checked. Junior shooters may be NRA members of members of an NRA affiliated rifle club. Teams will consist of 2 firing members and a Captain and/or Coach, and may include one alternate. The Captain/Coach may be a firing member of the team. Teams will represent an NRA affiliated club (Rule 2.11), a law enforcement agency (Rule 2.14), a regular or reserve armed forces unit (Rule 2.13), or a State Association (Rule 2.12). Teams will not be classified. All team members must have been bona-fide members of the organization they represent for at least 30 days prior to the date of the tournament. Pickup teams are encouraged to shoot but will not qualify for the State Championship. The CMP-EIC Match is open to any US citizen 12 years of older.

FEES: State Championship Tournament Fee.....\$35.00 (\$4.00 of this to MRRA for trophies) seniors (Rule 2.2.1) and juniors (Rule 2.3) are eligible for a \$5.00 discount.
NRA fee \$5.50 per shooter
Team Match Fees (per 2 person team).....\$10.00
EIC-LEG Match Fee.....\$15.00
Challenges: (Rule 16.1).....\$2.00
Team only shooters must pay an additional \$5.50 for NRA registration fee

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA classification system will be used in all individual matches. Please have your NRA classification card or temporary score book with you. For class awards there must be at least five entries in that class. If there are less than five, those shooters will be combined with the next higher class. High Masters cannot be combined with any other class and can only compete for Match Winner awards if there are fewer than five shooters in the High Master class. Shooters without a classification card will shoot in the Master/Unclassified (MU) class (rule 19.6)

RIFLES: Service rifles (Rules 3.1, 3.1.1, 3.1.2) are allowed. The same rifle must be used in all individual matches unless declared disabled by the Chief Range Officer (Rule 9.6)

RULES: Current NRA High Power rules will govern the matches. All competitors will score and pull targets. Competitors who fail to present themselves at the proper place and time may lose the right to participate in tournament.

AWARDS: Award payback depends on number of entries. The 10% rule will apply to each class. There must be at least 5 entries in a class for awards. There will be separate category awards for high woman, high senior and high junior if at least 5 in that category. Class and category winners can be the same person if all other criteria met. Minnesota state champion will be the high resident score and will receive a MRRA plaque. If match winner is a non resident that person will receive the same type plaque stating they are the match winner.

LOCATION: Northstar Rifle Club is located northwest of Red Wing Minn. Off hwy 61 to mile marker 98. Turn south on Greenspring Road. Follow Greenspring about 1 mile to range. IGNORE KEEP OUT SIGNS AT RANGE GATE!

ENTRIES: Advance entry is recommended to insure your participation. Entries will be capped at 80

shooters for the individual matches and 20 teams for the team matches. Advance entries will close at 5:00 P.M. on Friday Sept. 16, 2011. We will hold your entry until one half hour before the matches begin. If you have not registered by that time your spot will be made available to another participant. Post (walk in) entries will be accepted until 8:25 A.M. on Saturday Sept. 17, or until the 80 shooter limit is reached, whichever comes first. Send advance entries with the appropriate fees to:

FIRING STARTS: The individual State Championship Regional Match course will start at 9:00 A.M. on Saturday Sept. 17, 2011. The pits will seal at 8:45 A.M. both days. The remainder of the team match will start at 9:00 A.M. on Sunday Sept. 18, pits seal at 0845. The EIC-LEG match will start approximately one-half hour after the end of the team match. Registration for the EIC-LEG match will start at approximately 1100.

MATCH COURSE: Special notice – The NRA has given us a special allowance to have each relay shoot the sitting rapid fire stage (Match 2) right after the standing stage (Match 1) is fired, so be prepared to do so.

80 Shot Regional Match Course (Rule 7.15) as follows:

Match 1: 200 yards, standing, slow fire, 2 sighters, 20 rounds for record, time – 22 minutes
Match 2: 200 yards, sitting, rapid fire, 2 sighters, 2 ten shots strings for record, time – 60 seconds each string.
Match 3: 300 yards, prone, rapid fire, 2 sighters, 2 ten shot strings for record, time – 70 seconds each string.
Match 4: 600 yards, prone, slow fire, 2 sighters, 20 shots for record, time – 22 minutes.
Match 5: Grand aggregate of matches 1, 2, 3 and 4.

2 PERSON TEAM: Each individual will fire 50 shots for record. Approximately 30 min. after completion of the individual championship 600 yd. match on Sat. each team member will fire stage 4 of the team match. NO SIGHTING SHOTS & 20 shots for record, time limit 43 min. per pair. The remainder of the team match will be fired as shown below on Sun. One shooter will coach & one will shoot. Enemy teams will send one member to the pit & the other will score. Upon completion of 2 shooters they will swap with the working team. Sunday one pair will shoot standing & sitting then swap. The 2nd pair will shoot standing, sitting & 300. The first pair will then shoot 300 RF.

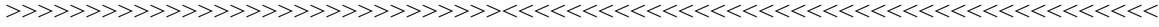
STAGE 1: 200 yards, standing, slow fire, ten shots for record per shooter. Two shooters will pair fire. Time limit per pair – 23 minutes per pair.
STAGE 2: 200 yards, sitting, rapid fire, ten shots for record per shooter, time – 60 seconds per string.
STAGE 3: 300 yards, prone, rapid fire, ten shots for record per shooter, time – 70 Seconds per string.
AGGREGATE: Grand Aggregate of stages 1, 2, 3, & 4 for each shooter.

EIC-LEG Match as follows approximate start time 11:30 AM.

STAGE 1: 200 yards, standing, slow fire, 10 rounds for record, time – 10 minutes.
STAGE 2: 200 yards, sitting, rapid fire, 1 ten round string, time – 60 seconds.
STAGE 3: 300 yards, prone, rapid fire, 1 ten round string, time – 70 seconds.
STAGE 4: 600 yards, prone, slow fire, 20 rounds for record, time – 20 minutes.
AGGREGATE: 50 Shot National Match Course – Aggregate of stages 1, 2, 3 and 4.

Firearm is the service rifle, NRA rules 3.1, 3.1.1, or 3.1.2. Competitors must furnish their own ammunition, 30.06, 7.62mm, or 5.56. Awards will be furnished by mail from the CMP

Targets: 200 yards – SR Target; 300 yards – SR3 target; 600 yards – MR1 target
