The North Star Rifle Club is proud to offer a 2 day CMP sanctioned EIC rifle tournament on Sept 19 & 20, 2015. You will have 2 opportunities to earn the coveted "leg" points in 1 fun filled weekend. And to make this more attractive NSRC will offer as part of your Sat entry fee a FREE 30 shot 2 relay practice match at 0900. You will shoot 10 shots each standing slow fire, sitting rapid fire & 300 prone RF while keeping your own score. Squadding for practice will CLOSE at 0835 followed by safety briefing and pits seal at 0850. MRRA has free loaner AR15 rifles if you need one to try a leg match. Contact MRRA rifle keeper Tom Torborg for further information tjtorborg@aol.com. Shooters will provide their own ammunition.

North Star rifle club is located in the scenic Cannon River valley a few miles west of Red Wing Minnesota. Highway 61 to mile marker 99 just west of Cannon River bridge and turn west on Green Spring Road up the big hill. Follow Green Spring Rd. about 1 mile to range entrance. Observe 20 MPH speed limit on Green Spring & watch for 10 MPH speed at the top of the hill.

Rules; Current CMP/NRA rules apply. Service rifles only allowed (NRA rules 3.1, 3.1.1 or 3.1.2. M1 Garand, M1-A or AR-15) All triggers will be weighed prior to firing.

Eligibility; Competition is open to all. Juniors under eighteen years old must have an adult on the range at all times. Affidavit must be on file.

Entries; Limited to sixty shooters on 3 relays each day. Entry fee is \$20.00 each day. Entry at range only and priority given to non distinguished.

10 shots slow-fire standing 200 yards, ten minute time limit.

10 shots sitting rapid-fire, 200 yards, 60 second time limit

10 shots prone rapid-fire, 300 yards, 70 second time limit

20 shots prone slow-fire 600 yards, 20 minute time limit.

Targets; 200 yards-SR Target. 300 yards-SR3 target. 600 yards MR-1 target.

Sun EIC Course of Fire starting at 0900. Squadding opens at 0800 and closes at 0835 followed by safety briefing and pits seal at 0850.

10 shots slow-fire standing 200 yards, ten minute time limit.

10 shots sitting rapid-fire, 200 yards, 60 second time limit

10 shots prone rapid-fire, 300 yards, 70 second time limit

20 shots prone slow-fire 600 yards, 20 minute time limit.

Targets; 200 yards-SR Target. 300 yards-SR3 target. 600 yards MR-1 target

Awards; This match is run for the purpose of attaining EIC "Leg" points for the Distinguished Rifleman Award. CMP supplies gold, silver & bronze medals as well as credit toward distinguished status.
