

**Northwestern Gun Club (C0669)
The Poor Man's Perry Match
NRA Approved Match**

DATE: August 6 & 7, 2010

TIME: Registration will begin at 0730am. Registration closes at 0830am and the pit will be sealed at 0845. Firing begins at 0900am.

LOCATION: Northwestern Gun Club, Hunters Lake, 20 miles northwest of Duluth, MN.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all shooters. However, the NWGC reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.

RULES: Current NRA High Power Rifle Rules will govern throughout the match where applicable.

RIFLES: Rule 3.1 Service Rifle, Rule 3.2 Any Rifle, Rule 3.3 Match Rifle, Rule 3.4 F-Class

EQUIPMENT: NRA rule 9.1 pertaining to changing of rifles between matches applies for Saturday OTC.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA Classification system will be used.

DUTIES: Scoring and pulling targets is required. These duties may be performed by the competitor, or may be performed by any competent substitute provided by the competitor. Failure to fulfill these duties will result in disqualification.

MATCH SCHEDULE:

Saturday:

Targets: 200 yards SR Target; 300 yards SR-3 Target; 500 yards MR-65 Target.

Match 1 2 Sighters 20 Shots, slow fire standing, in 22 Minutes at 200 yards.

Match 2 2 Sighters 20 Shots, rapid fire sitting, 60 seconds per string at 200 yards.

Match 3 2 Sighters 20 Shots, rapid fire prone, 70 seconds per string at 300 yards.

Match 4 2 Sighters 20 Shots, slow fire prone, in 22 minutes at 500 yards.

Match 5 Aggregate of matches 1 through 4.

Sunday:

Targets: MR65 Target 500 yards; or F-Class

Match 6 2 Sighters 20 Shots, slow fire prone, any rifle/any sight in 22 Minutes at 500 yards

Match 7 2 Sighters 20 Shots, slow fire prone, any rifle/any sight in 22 Minutes at 500 yards

Match 8 2 Sighters 20 Shots, slow fire prone, any rifle/iron sight in 22 Minutes at 500 yards

Match 9 2 Sighters 20 Shots, slow fire prone, any rifle/iron sight in 22 Minutes at 500 yards

Match 10 Aggregate of matches 6 thru 9

AWARDS: A 10% award schedule will apply. 40% of the entry fees will be paid to the competitors as awards. If there are less than five competitors entered in a class they will be combined with the next higher class, except no class will be combined with the High Master class. If there are less than five competitors entered in the High Master class they will be eligible for Match Winner awards only. There will be awards for competitors firing Service Rifle if five or more entries in this category. High Junior and High Woman awards will be presented in the event that there are three or more competitors in these categories.

ENTRY FEES: Advanced entries are encouraged, but not required. Squading preference will be given to advanced entries only.
