

Northwestern Gun Club (C0669)
The Livingston Match
NRA Approved Match

DATE: June 7 & 8, 2008

TIME: Registration will begin at 0730. Registration closes at 0830 and the pit will be sealed at 0850. Firing begins at 0900.

LOCATION: Northwestern Gun Club, Hunters Lake, 20 miles northwest of Duluth, MN.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all shooters. However, the NWGC reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.

RULES: Current NRA High Power Rifle Rules will govern throughout the match where applicable.

RIFLES: Rule 3.1 Service Rifle, Rule 3.3 Match Rifle

EQUIPMENT: NRA rule 9.1 pertaining to changing of rifles between matches applies.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA Classification system will be used.

TARGETS: 200 yards SR Target; 300 yards SR-3 Target; 500 yards MR-65 Target.

DUTIES: Scoring and pulling targets is required. These duties may be performed by the competitor, or may be performed by any competent substitute provided by the competitor. Failure to fulfill these duties will result in disqualification.

MATCH SCHEDULE:

Saturday:

Match 1	2 Sighters 20 Shots, slow fire standing, in 22 Minutes
Match 2	2 Sighters 20 Shots, rapid fire sitting from standing, 60 seconds per string.
Match 3	2 Sighters 20 Shots, rapid fire prone from standing, 70 seconds per string.
Match 4	2 Sighters 20 Shots, slow fire prone, in 22 minutes.
Match 5	Aggregate of matches 1 through 4.

Sunday:

- Match 6 2 Sights 20 Shots, slow fire standing, in 22 Minutes
- Match 7 2 Sights 20 Shots, rapid fire sitting from standing, 60 seconds per string.
- Match 8 2 Sights 20 Shots, rapid fire prone from standing, 70 seconds per string.
- Match 9 2 Sights 20 Shots, slow fire prone, in 22 minutes.
- Match 10 Aggregate of matches 6 through 9.
- Match 11 Grand Aggregate match 5 plus match 10.

AWARDS: A 10% award schedule will apply. 40% of the entry fees will be paid to the competitors as awards. If there are less than five competitors entered in a class they will be combined with the next higher class, except no class will be combined with the High Master class. If there are less than five competitors entered in the High Master class they will be eligible for Match Winner awards only. There will be awards for competitors firing Service Rifle if five or more entries in this category. High Junior and High Woman awards will be presented in the event that there are three or more competitors in these categories.

ENTRY FEES: Advanced entries are encouraged, but not required. Squading preference will be given to advanced entries only.
