Rule: Current indoor NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules will govern. All matches will be shot in a relay format. All guns not currently in use must be placed on the gun rack and have an empty chamber indicator in gun.

ELEGIBILITY: Open to any individual member of the NRA. Junior competitors may be individual members of the NRA or members of an NRA affiliated Junior Rifle Club. For open shoot, the state champion must be a state resident and current member of Minnesota Rifle and Revolver Association (MRRA.org is the website to join online).

The open teams will consist of four person teams, firing a 400-point match each and fired after the open state match.

The junior teams will be four person teams with their junior championship scores used for the team scores. No coach will be allowed for any juniors on the firing line.

ENTRIES: Individual entries can be made at the range on the match day. NRA classification and NRA number will be needed. Please make checks payable to Fergus Falls Rifle & Pistol Club.

Juniors: Entries will be limited to 20 shooters on the evening of April 16th and possibly 30 shooters on the morning of April 17th.

Open: Entries will be limited to 20 shooters on the afternoon of April 17th and 20 shooters on the morning of April 18th.

TIME OF FIRING: On April 16th firing will commence at 7:00 PM (junior shoot)
On April 17th firing will commence at 9:00 AM (junior shoot)
On April 17th firing will commence at 2:00 PM (open shoot) - team shooting will follow after completion of match.
On April 18th firing will commence at 9:00 AM (open shoot) - team shooting will follow after completion of match.

NRA FOUR POSITION CONVENTIONAL

INDIVIDUAL MATCHES

All firing will be done on A-17 targets

Junior

- Match No. 1 10 shots Prone at 50 feet, Metallic Sights, 10 shots / 10 minutes
- Match No. 2 10 shots Standing at 50 feet, Metallic Sights, 10 shots / 15 minutes
- Match No. 3 10 shots Sitting at 50 feet, Metallic Sights, 10 shots / 10 minutes
- Match No. 4 10 shots Kneeling at 50 feet, Metallic Sights, 10 shots / 10 minutes
- Match No. 5 Aggregate of scores from one through four - no fee if Matches 1-4 are paid.

Open

- Match No. 1 20 shots Prone at 50 feet, Any Sights, 20 shots / 20 minutes
- Match No. 2 20 shots Standing at 50 feet, Any Sights, 20 shots / 30 minutes
- Match No. 3 20 shots Sitting at 50 feet, Any Sights, 20 shots / 20 minutes
- Match No. 4 20 shots Kneeling at 50 feet, Any Sights, 20 shots / 20 minutes
- Match No. 5 Aggregate of scores from one through four - no fee if Matches 1-4 are paid.
- Match No. 6 Team Shoot - 40 shots at 50 feet - all positions, Any Sights, 40 shots / 45 minutes

CLASSIFICATION:

Juniors: Classification will be made by age.

Open: The NRA classification system will be used in all matches. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6 - assigned Classification, or 19.2 - Temporary Classification, may be used in making entry in an NRA four position conventional tournament.

AWARDS

Juniors: Match winner of matches 1 - 5 will receive a trophy. Only the First and Second placings will be awarded in the advanced age group and will receive medallions. The remaining age groups will be awarded First, Second and Third place medallions.

Open: MN State Champion will be awarded to the MN state resident and member of MRRA who shoots highest overall Match No. 5 score.

Each classification will receive NRA award points for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in each match. All classes will require a minimum of five participants or will be moved up to next class level. The number of points awarded will be determined by number of participants in matches. The NRA points will be mailed to winners after completion of the tournament.
