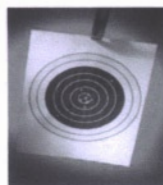


South Dakota Shooting Sports Association in Cooperation with

South Dakota State Indoor Pistol Championship - Eastern Division

March 9th, 2014



The South Dakota Indoor Pistol Championship will be shot in 2 divisions. The Western Division will be shot in Rapid City and the Eastern Division will be shot in Garretson. The State Champions will be the result of the **Combined Scores from BOTH matches**. The Combined Results will be given to each competitor and posted on the SDSSA Website. Shooters can shoot in which ever match is most convenient for them to attend.

Match Date/Times We will shoot 2 relays with a max of 10 shooters per relay.
Relays times are: 1st @ 10:00 am - 2nd @ 12:00pm

Rules: Current NRA Pistol Rules Govern Any 22 cal Pistol or Revolver (rule 3.4)

Distance & Targets: Fifty (50) feet using official NRA targets.
This is the B2 for slow fire and the B3 for timed and rapid fire

Course of Fire: Match 1- 20rds - 2 slow fire targets for a max score of 200. (B2 Targets)
Match 2- 30rds National Match Course..
One Slow fire, One Timed Fire and One Rapid Fire Target. Max Score of 300.
Match 3- 20rds timed fire - 2 timed fire targets for a max score of 200. (B3 Targets)
Match 4 - 20rds rapid fire - 2 rapid fire targets for a max score of 200. (B3 Targets)
Match 5- SD Individual Championship, Aggregate of Matches 1-4
Match 6- Team Championship, Team Members Score of Match 2

Eligibility: Open to those who are SD Shooting Sports members or members of their resident state's Shooting Organization...Bring Your Membership Card! Jr. Competitors (18yrs & under) maybe members of a SDSSA affiliated club. Team members must represent the same Club, Law Enforcement Group, Military Unit or State Association Club. No pick up teams.

NRA Membership is encouraged but not required!

The South Dakota State Champion must be a member of the SDSSA and a resident of South Dakota!
SDSSA Memberships are available the day of the shoot.

Entries: Entries will be accepted on the day of the match starting at 9:00am

Shooter Classification: All competitors will be classified according to the NRA Classification System in all matches. Be ready to show your classification cards and or score books upon request. All Unclassified competitors will shoot in the Master Class.

Cash Awards: Cash Awards at this match will be determined by the Match Director based on attendance.

SD State Indoor Senior Champion (60+) and SD State Indoor Jr. Champion Award (18yrs & under) will be provided if 2 or more competitors compete in each of those classes.
