THE ROAD WILL TWIST AND TURNS SOME. STONE CITY ROAD BECOMES MATSELL ROAD. CROSS THE WAPSIPINICON RIVER TURN RIGHT IMMEDIATELY. THIS IS A LINN COUNTY PARK FACILITY. OPEN TO THE PUBLIC. THE RANGE IS 300 YARDS FROM THE PARK RANGERS RESIDENCE.

RULES: NRA RULES WILL GOVERN MATCH. \$1.00 CHALLENGE FEE. REFIRES AND ALIBIS ARE ALLOWED. COMPETITORS WILL SCORE AND REPAIR TARGETS. BRING A STAPLE GUN

CLASSIFICATION: NRA CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM WILL BE USED. UNCLASSIFIED COMPETITORS WILL FIRE IN THE MASTER CLASS. ANY CLASS WITH LESS THAN 5 WILL BE COMBINED WITH THE NEXT HIGHER CLASS STARTING WITH MARKSMAN CLASS. LESS THAN 5 MASTERS WILL SHOOT FOR WIN ONLY.

.22 ONLY AGGREGATE MATCH

Course of Fire -Shooters will shoot standard courses of fire shoulder-to-shoulder with other shooters competing in open NRA Pistol competition. However, shooters will shoot the .22 Caliber pistol described in Rule 3.4 in all three phases of a standard 2700 aggregate instead of changing pistols during the center-fire and .45 caliber matches. They will record aggregates in the same manner as other shooters shooting more than one caliber of pistol, but will compete only against other eligible .22 Caliber Only Aggregate shooters and will only be eligible for awards designated for the .22 Caliber Aggregate Competition events except as provided in Rule 22.1. Just as each open class competitor will compile 900 point and 2700-point aggregates using more than one gun, the .22 Caliber only competitors will compile those aggregates with only one firearm as described, in NRA Pistol Rule(s).

AWARDS: AWARDS WILL BE IN CASH. NO COMPETITOR MAY RECEIVE MORE THAN ONE AWARD PER MATCH.

The CMP Rim fire EIC Match for credit toward Distinguished designation will be fired each day after the distinguished revolver match. See CMP rule 6.4 for approved firearms. Entry fee \$15
